### CONSULTATION PHASE TODAY *thru* APRIL 2018

#### WHAT HAPPENS DURING THIS TIME

- ◆ Bishop Zubik consults with priests and lay leaders from his advisory councils.
- ◆ He will consider their feedback in discerning his final decisions.

#### WHAT DOES **NOT** HAPPEN DURING THIS TIME

- ◆ **NO** announcements are made.
- ◆ **NO** changes take place.

### TRANSITION PHASE APRIL 2018 *thru* FALL 2018

#### WHAT HAPPENS DURING THIS TIME

- ◆ Final Parish Groupings
- ◆ Clergy Assignments
- ◆ # of Masses per Grouping
- ◆ Blueprints that will guide Implementation

Outgoing and incoming clergy work to develop new Mass schedule

#### WHAT DOES **NOT** HAPPEN DURING THIS TIME

- ◆ **NO** clergy move.
- ◆ **NO** Mass schedules

### IMPLEMENTATION PHASE FALL 2018 *and* ONWARD

#### WHAT HAPPENS DURING THIS TIME

- ◆ New Clergy Assignments begin—One clergy team will be assigned to serve all parishes in each grouping.
- ◆ New Mass schedule begins.

#### WHAT DOES **NOT** HAPPEN DURING THIS TIME

- ◆ **NO** immediate parish mergers.
- ◆ **NO** immediate closing of church buildings.
